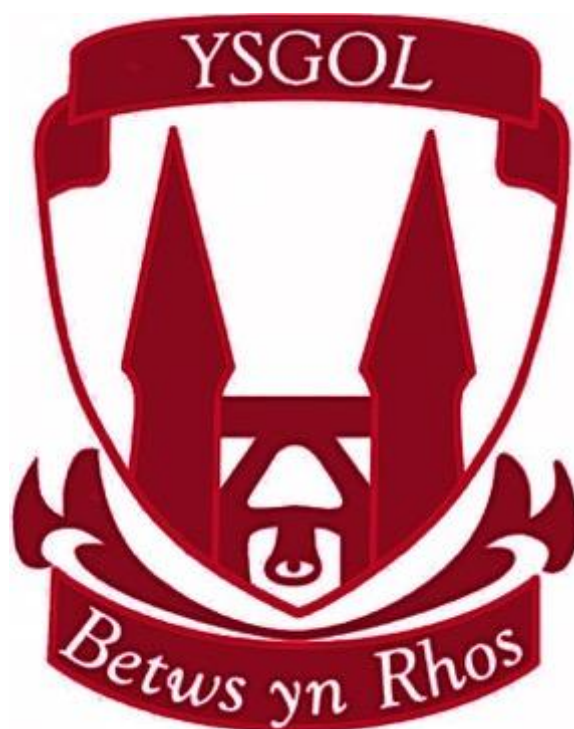

Math O Ysgol

Ysgol Wirfoddol Reoledig yr Eglwys yng Nghymru ydy Ysgol Betws yn Rhos, ysgol wledig a gafodd ei sefydlu yn 1861. Mae ein hysgol yn un gyd-addysgol ddyddiol ar gyfer bechgyn a merched rhwng 3 – 11 oed sy'n cynnig Addysg trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg, gyda 2 aelod o staff dysgu llawn amser, 3 rhan amser, a phedwar dosbarth. Ar hyn o bryd mae 67 o ddisgyblion llawn amser a 12 o blant Meithrin. Gwneir defnydd o Neuadd y Pentref a'r cae chwarae lleol sydd ger yr ysgol ar gyfer gwersi Addysg Gorfforol. Mae pentref Betws yn Rhos bedair milltir tu allan i dref Abergele.

Type Of School

We are a Voluntary Controlled Church in Wales Primary School, a rural school that was established in 1861. It is a day co-educational school for girls and boys aged 3 to 11, offering Primary Education through the medium of Welsh with 2 full time and 3 part time members of teaching staff working in four classrooms. At present there are 67 full time pupils and 12 Nursery children. The Village Hall and local sports field, which are situated next to the school, are used for Physical Education. The village is four miles from Abergele.

Teachers plan termly schemes of work for their class in conjunction with National Curriculum 2008 requirements, Revised Programmes of Learning for Welsh, English and Mathematics, the school's Long Term Schemes of Work and Topic Cycle. At the moment the school are planning and preparing for the new curriculum that will be statutory from 2022 onwards.

The Early Years follow a programme of learning based on the Foundation Phase Framework. If a teacher is absent because of illness or training needs we will follow the guidelines in our Rarely Cover policy.

Gwerthfawrogrir presenoldeb prydlon ar ddechrau pob sesiwn. Ni ddylai plant gyrraedd yr ysgol cyn 8:50 y.b. pan fydd y staff ar ddyletswydd i dderbyn y disgyblion wrth y giat i'w hebrwng i'r iard. Nid oes angen i'r rhieni ddod ar yr iard.

Addysgir y Cyfnod Sylfaen am 21 awr yr wythnos a'r disgyblion Cyfnod Allweddol 2 am 23½ awr yr wythnos yn ôl canllawiau'r Llywodraeth Cymru.

Ni chaniateir i ddisgyblion adael safle'r ysgol yn ystod y dydd oni bai fod eglurhad wedi ei dderbyn ymlaen llaw gan rieni.

Bydd yr ysgol yn sicrhau gofal ac iechyd y disgyblion tra yn ein gofal, a chedwir drysau'r ysgol ar glo yn ystod oriau dysgu er budd diogelwch bawb. Cyfrifoldeb rhieni ydy'r plant cyn 8:50 y.b. cyn iddynt gyrraedd safle'r ysgol, ac ar ôl 3:30yp neu ar ôl iddynt adael safle'r ysgol. Rhybuddiwn pawb i gymryd gofal arbennig ar y maes parcio gyda cheir, pan fydd plant yn cael eu hebrwng yn ôl ac ymlaen o'r ysgol.

Cawn ddau amser chwarae yn ystod y dydd, sef yn y bore o 10:30 – 10:45 ac yn y prynhawn rhwng 2:15-2:30pm. Bydd llefrith ar gael yn rhad ac am ddim yn ddyddiol i'r Babanod. Gall disgyblion ddod a ffrwyth eu hunain i'r ysgol ar gyfer amser chwarae'r bore.

Paratoir cinio yng nghegin yr ysgol yn ddyddiol i bawb os ydynt yn dymuno am £13.75 yr wythnos i'r Babanod a'r plant lau. Y mae cinio'r ysgol yn ginio iach. Caniateir i blant ddod â brechdanau at amser cinio os ydy rhieni'n dymuno ond pwysleisir y dylai'r pecyn bwyd fod yn un iach. Bydd y plant yn cael eu hebrwng i'r Neuadd i gael eu cinio. Derbynnir yr arian cinio trwy'r system Parentpay os gwelwch yn dda. I'r rhai sydd yn gymwys, mae cinio am ddim ar gael. Gellir cysylltu â swyddfeydd y sir yn Bodlondeb, Conwy ynghylch yr hawl i ginio am ddim, a bydd angen i chi gwblhau'r broses cyn y bydd wedi ei awdurdodi. Cynigir bwydlen iachus gyda dewis i bob disgybl sy'n cynnwys ffrwythau a llysiau ffres a heb fod yn cynnwys ychwanegion. Gellir paratoi cinio ar gyfer plant â gofynion meddygol arbennig hefyd.

Hebryngir y plant at y giat amser mynd adre, a bydd athrawes ar ddyletswydd yn gofalu fod pob plentyn yn cyrraedd ei riant/ gwarchodwr / tacsî yn ddiogel. Os bydd rhiant yn methu cyrraedd mewn pryd, yna gwerthfawrogrir neges ffôn i egluro hynny, a rhoi caniatad i rywun arall nôl y plentyn.

Teaching Hours and School Day

The school hours are as follows:

Morning session:	9:00 - 12:00	Meithrin 9:00 - 11:00
Afternoon - Foundation Stage	1:00 - 3:00	
Key Stage 2	1:00 - 3:30	

Punctuality is expected at all times. Children should not arrive at school before 8:50a.m, when staff will be on duty at the gate to welcome pupils and escort them to their class. There is no need for parents to enter the school yard.

Teaching hours during a normal week comply with Welsh Government recommendations – 21 hours for Foundation Stage and 23½ hours for Key stage 2 pupils.

Pupils are not allowed to leave the school premises during the day unless this has been authorised by parents.

The school maintains health and safety arrangements for the pupils during the school day, and school doors are locked during lesson times to maintain security. Pupils are the parents' responsibility before 8:50 a.m and before they are on school premises, and after 3:30pm when they have left school premises. We ask that everyone takes extra care on the car park with cars whilst pupils are escorted to and from school.

We have two playtimes during the day, one in the morning from 10:30 – 10:45a.m, and one in the afternoon between 2:15-2:30pm. Free milk is available daily for all Infants. Pupils can bring a piece of fruit for morning playtime if they wish.

A school dinner is prepared on site and served every day for all pupils at a cost of £13.75 per week for Infants, and Juniors. School dinners are healthy ones. Children can opt to bring their own packed lunch should parents prefer but we do stress that the content should be healthy. Pupils are escorted to the Village Hall for their lunch. Dinner money is paid through the Parentpay system. For those who are eligible, free school meals can be obtained by contacting Bodlonddeb county offices in Conwy. Please ensure process has been completed before assuming entitlement to free school meals. A nutritionally balanced menu with choices is available to all pupils containing fresh fruit and vegetables which is free from additives and colourants. Any special dietary requirements, with supporting medical advice, may also be catered for.

Pupils are escorted to the gate at home time, and the teacher on duty will release them to parents, guardians or taxis safely. Parents must notify the school by phone or letter if unable to collect their child, and inform the school if someone other than yourself is collecting your child.

Polisi Derbyn yr Ysgol

Yn unol a Pholisi Derbyn yr Adran Addysg, derbynnir plant amser llawn ym mis Medi yn dilyn eu penblwydd yn 4oed. Derbynnir plant i'r dosbarth Meithrin rhan amser ym mis Medi yn dilyn eu penblwydd yn 3 oed. Bydd y plant Meithrin yn derbyn addysg hanner amser ac yn mynychu'r ysgol bob bore o 9:00- 11:00 o'r gloch.

Bydd cyfle i'r plant fydd yn cychwyn yn y dosbarth Meithrin ym mis Medi i dreulio hanner diwrnod yn y dosbarth yn ystod diwedd tymor yr Haf blaenorol, er mwyn eu helpu i ymgartrefu.

School Admission Policy

The school adopts the Local Education Authority's Admission Policy. Pupils are admitted into full time education in the September following their 4th birthday. A child can be admitted into the Nursery class part time in the September following their 3rd birthday. Nursery pupils will receive part time education, and will attend school every morning from 9:00 – 11:00am.

New Nursery intake are invited to spend an induction morning at the school during the end of the summer term prior to admission.



Ethos

Gan gydnabod ei sylfaen hanesyddol bydd yr ysgol yn cadw ac yn datblygu ei chymeriad crefyddol yn unol ag egwyddorion yr Eglwys yng Nghymru ac mewn partneriaeth â'r Eglwys ar lefel plwyf ac esgobaeth. 'Fel Ysgol Reoledig Wirfoddol yr Eglwys yng Nghymru, yn Ysgol Betws yn Rhos rydym yn ceisio adnabod daioni ym mhob plentyn. Daioni y credwn sy'n deillio o Dduw. Rydym yn eu helpu i'w adnabod yn ei gilydd a'r byd o'u hamgylch. Rhoddir addysg y disgyblion o fewn cyd-destun cred ac ymarfer Cristnogol, ac yn hyrwyddo gwerthoedd Cristnogol trwy'r profiad mae'n ei gynnig i bob disgybl. Anelwn i annog eu synnwyr naturiol o barch a phleser, a chryfhau eu ffydd, gobaith a chariad fel sylfaen gadarn i adeiladu eu bywydau arni.'

Nod yr ysgol yw gwasanaethu ei chymuned trwy ddarparu addysg o'r ansawdd uchaf o fewn cyd-destun cred ac ymarfer Cristnogol. Mae'n annog dealltwriaeth o ystyr ac arwyddocad ffydd ac yn hyrwyddo gwerthoedd Cristnogol trwy'r profiad y mae'n ei gynnig i'w holl ddisgyblion.

Byddwn yn datblygu perthynas glos rhwng athrawon â phlant gan roi cefnogaeth llwyr pan fo'r angen. Cedwir rheolau'r ysgol yn syml ac fe hyrwyddir disgyblaeth bendant. Rhwir cosb pan fo angen drwy atal breintiau.

Byddwn yn sefydlu agwedd iach o fewn yr ysgol i ddatblygu hunanbarch a hunanddisgyblaeth, ystyried eraill ac i dderbyn gwerthoedd moesol.

Wrth gyflwyno'r Cwricwlwm fe ofalwn fod cynnwys a natur y gwaith yn gymwys ar gyfer oed a gallu'r unigolyn fel bod gwahaniaethu addas ar gyfer anghenion pob plentyn.

- Datblygu a hybu ymwybyddiaeth o werthoedd moesol, ysbrydol a chrefyddol.
- Cynyddu medusrwydd sgiliau allweddol pob plentyn.
- Darparu ar gyfer plant ag anghenion dysgu ychwanegol, boed nhw'n anghenion addysgol neu'n blant MAT.

Aims and Objectives

Our aim is to create an establishment with a happy caring and friendly atmosphere, where there is trust, confidence and openness, where individual contributions are valued, where praise and recognition can be given, and support offered when difficulties are encountered.

This approach is conducive to the personal, social and moral development of each child.

The Basic Skills of Literacy, Numeracy, Problem Solving and ICT are taught within the National Curriculum which covers the following areas:-

The school aims to establish a healthy attitude to learning, to develop self respect and self discipline. School rules are kept simple and we promote positive discipline. Where punishment is necessary this takes the form of a reprimand and withdrawal from certain privileges.

We endeavour to instil in the pupils a healthy attitude towards school life and to develop self respect, self discipline, regard for others and acceptance of moral values.

When presenting the Curriculum, the school is careful in ensuring that the content and nature of the work is designed to suit the pupil's needs bearing in mind age and stage of learning.

Pupils with Additional Learning Needs or Disabilities The school has Policies regarding pupils with ALN or disabilities which ensure that these pupils are not treated less favourably than other pupils. We also have an accessibility Plan detailing how we are currently providing and how we will provide for pupils with disabilities in the future.

Specific objectives

The school's philosophy and intentions are: -

- To enable each child to develop his/her full potential.
- To ensure that every child is offered a broad learning programme that is all based around the Four Main Purposes of the new curriculum.
- To develop a healthy attitude to learning, and create in each child a desire to learn, to understand, and seek further knowledge through interest.
- To assist each child to live and work with others, and to develop attitudes which will enable him/her to become a responsible member of the community.
- To develop and encourage an awareness of moral, spiritual and Christian values.
- To increase each child's capability to develop their key skills.
- To provide for pupils with additional learning needs, including the pupils with various learning difficulties or MAT pupils.
- To teach every child to communicate clearly, coherently and with confidence and to set clear targets with the aim for every child to become as fluent as possible in both Welsh and English.
- To provide ample opportunities for pupils to develop and to develop a pride in their Welshness and identity.

The Governing Body is aware of its duty to allow parents to inspect:

- Any statutory instrument and circulars sent to school by the national Assembly about powers and duties of Governing Bodies.
- Any published Inspection Reports on the school.
- Any other documents relating to the National Curriculum.



Polisi Iaith

Cymraeg yw iaith swyddogol yr ysgol a disgwylir i'r disgyblion siarad Cymraeg a'i gilydd gyda'r nôd y byddant yn hollol ddwyieithog erbyn iddynt gyrraedd un ar ddeg oed. Defnyddir y Gymraeg a'r Saesneg yn yr ysgol fel cyfrwng addysgu yng Nghyfnod Allweddol 2. Ein nôd yw galluogi pob plentyn i fod mor rhugl â phosib yn y ddwy iaith erbyn ddiwedd eu cyfnod yn yr ysgol.

Language Policy



Welsh is the official language of the school and it is expected that the pupils speak Welsh together. The aim of the school is that the children will be completely bilingual by the time they are eleven years of age. Both Welsh and English are used as a teaching medium within Key Stage 2. Our aim is to enable every child to become as fluent as possible in both languages by the end of their time in school.

Gwaith Cartref

Gosodir gwaith cartref yn achlysurol yn y babanod ac yn rheoliadd yn yr adran lau. Anfonnir llyfr darllen adre gyda'r plentyn bob dydd yn rheolaidd fel rhan o'r gwaith cartref. Gwerthfawrogir unrhyw gefnogaeth a gaiff y plant gyda'u gwaith ysgol, a bydd yr athrawon bob amser yn barod i roi unrhyw gyngor neu gymorth.

Homework

Homework is set occasionally in the infants and regularly in the junior department. A reading book is sent home with the child every day. Any support given to children with their schoolwork is appreciated. Teachers will always be willing to give advice when it is requested.

Cyswllt â rhieni

Gwna pob aelod o staff yr ymdrech i sicrhau fod pob plentyn yn hapus, cartrefol a hyderus yn yr ysgol. Estynnir croeso i rieni ymweld â'r ysgol ar unrhyw adeg sy'n gyfleus i bawb. Gwahoddir rhieni i'r ysgol yn swyddogol i weld gwaith y plant ddwywaith y flwyddyn. Cynhelir y cyfarfod cyntaf ganol tymor yr Hydref, a'r llall ar ddiwedd tymor y Gwanwyn. Ar ddiwedd tymor yr Haf, cynhelir gwasanaeth ffarwelio â Blwyddyn 6 pryd y cyflwynir tystysgrifau a llyfrynau Cofnod Cyrhaeddiad i ddisgyblion blwyddyn 6.

Gwerthfawrogir y bydd rhai rhieni efallai angen sgwrs am eu plentyn ar adegau eraill, a gellir trefnu hyn drwy gysylltu â'r ysgol o flaen llaw. Anfonnir adroddiad ysgrifenedig i'r rhieni ar ddiwedd pob blwyddyn ysgol.

Home and school links

Everyone at the school makes every effort to try to ensure that children are happy and confident in school. Parents are welcome to visit school at a mutually convenient time. Parents are invited to come and see and discuss their child's work with the class teacher twice during the year. The first meeting is held mid Autumn term, and the other towards the end of the spring term. At the end of the summer term during our farwell service, certificates and Record of Achievement Booklets are presented to Year 6 pupils.

We appreciate that parents may wish to discuss issues at other times during the year and we ask you to consult school prior to any visit. A written progress report is sent home at the end of every school year.

Letters are sent to parents by email or by hand giving information about school activities and events. PTA meetings are held when fund raising or social events need to be arranged. We have a strong PTA committee that work hard raising funds towards the school.

ADDYSG GORFFOROL

Cynhelir Clwb Chwaraeon ar ôl ysgol bob dydd Mercher drwy gydweithrediad gyda Chris Law sy'n gyfrifol amdano. Trefnir clybiau peldroed a rygbi yn achlysurol hefyd.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Every child is taught Physical Education. The lessons are held at the Village Hall, and the sports field is used during the summer term for Games and Athletics. Suitable clothing must be worn for the lessons and PE bags should be brought to school at the beginning of each half term. Pupils are not allowed to wear jewellery for Physical Education lessons. The Juniors take part in the Urdd Sports and the Colwyn Bay and District Sports.

A Sports Club is held every Wednesday after school through close co-operation with Chris Law who runs it. Football and Rugby clubs are also held occasionally.

Addysg Iechyd a Rhyw

Cadarnhawyd gan y Corff Llywodraethol i addysg Iechyd a Rhyw gael ei gyflwyno a'i ddysgu o fewn cyd-destun y gwaith thema, ac yn ôl gofynion y Cwricwlwm Cenedlaethol, ac nid fel pynciau ar wahân. Gwahoddir nyrs yr ysgol i ymweld â phlant blwyddyn 6 yn ystod tymor yr haf i roi sgwrs a chynghor ynglyn â glendid personol a datblygiad corfforol.

Health and Sex Education

The Governing Body have agreed and confirmed that health and sex education should be taught at the school within the context of thematic work, and in accordance with National Curriculum requirements, and not taught as separate subjects. The teaching should encourage children to consider the value of a caring family life, moral issues, hygiene, and personal and social development. The school nurse is invited to school during the end of the summer term to talk and give advice to year 6 pupils about personal hygiene and physical development.

Gweithgareddau allgyrsiol ychwanegol

Rhoddir cyfle i'r plant ymgymryd ag amryw o weithgareddau tu allan i'r cwricwlwm arferol. Rhoddir cyfle i bob plentyn ymuno â'r Urdd ac i gynrychioli'r ysgol yn Eisteddfod yr Urdd, Eisteddfod Betws ac mewn cystadlaethau chwaraeon all gynnwys athletau, pêl rwyd, pêl droed, nofio, dawnsio a chyfnod mewn gwersyll gweithgareddau awyr agored. Rhoir cyfle i'r plant gystadlu gydag eitemau celf ac ysgrifenedig yn yr Urdd, Eisteddfod Betws yn Rhos a hefyd yn y sioe leol.

Rhoddir cyfle i ddisgyblion ddysgu chwarae offeryn cerdd ac yn bresennol medrwn gynnig gwersi llinynnol, bras a chwythbrennau. Ar ôl dod yn fwy rhugl, bydd cyfle i'r plant ymuno â cherddorfa ieuencid Conwy unwaith yr wythnos ar ôl ysgol.

Caiff disgyblion CA2 gyfle i ddilyn sesiynnau yn y Clwb Coginio yn flynyddol.

Yn achlysurol bydd ymweliadau'n cael eu trefnu ar gyfer y plant. Gan amlaf, bydd yr ysgol yn gofyn am gyfraniad gan rieni tuag at gost yr ymweliad a chost trafnidiaeth.

Pan fydd eich plentyn yn cychwyn ysgol, fe roddir ffurflen caniatad i rieni i'w llenwi, fydd yn caniatáu i'r plentyn gymeryd rhan mewn gweithgareddau tu allan i'r ysgol. Os oes gweithgaredd yn golygu aros dros nos, gofynnir i rieni lenwi ffurflen arall sy'n rhoi caniatad am y drefniadaeth a'r arolygiaeth.

Extra Curricular Activities

Pupils are given opportunities to participate in a variety of extra curricular activities. Every child gets the opportunity to join the Urdd (the Welsh Youth Movement). By joining, they can enjoy the various activities and competitions involved, to represent the school. These include musical, recitation, and Art competitions held at the Urdd Eisteddfod, our local Betws Eisteddfod or Show and also a variety of sports competitions, which may include athletics, football, swimming, netball, rugby, and a period at an outdoor sports centre.

Pupils are given the opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument. Peripatetic tutors visit the school weekly to provide brass, woodwind, and violin tuition. When they have made sufficient progress, pupils are invited to play weekly with the Conwy Orchestra.

Occasionally, educational visits are organised for the pupils. Voluntary contributions from parents will sometimes be necessary to help fund such activities towards the cost of the event and transport.

KS2 pupils are offered sessions in the Cookery Club annually.

On entry to school, all pupils are given a consent form (Form A) to be completed by parents, to give consent to their child participating in school activities outside school premises. If the activity involves staying overnight, then parents are asked

to complete another form (Form B) which gives details of inventory and supervision.

Absenoldeb

Mae bod yn bresennol yn yr ysgol yn rheolaidd a phrydlon yn holl bwysig. Heb hyn, all yr athro gorau gyflawni dim. Absences

Attending school regularly and punctually is vitally important. Without it, the best teacher's efforts would be to no avail. If your child is absent from school, please send a message or telephone us on the first morning of the absence. Regulations state that any unexplained absences will be classified as unauthorised absences. Children arriving late will have a late mark on the register. In the event of regular late arrivals, the school is required to report the situation to the LEA.

Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol

Additional Learning Needs

The school endeavours to cater for all pupils, some of whom have additional learning needs. Children who experience difficulty in certain areas of learning, will, with the consent of their parents, be offered extra help in the area causing concern. They will be withdrawn from class for one period each week to work with the Additional Learning Needs teacher. The class teacher will ensure that class work will suit the individual's needs and stage of learning. When Specialists help is required the school, after having parental consent, will consult with the LEA for support. Parents are informed of every development. The school's Additional Learning Needs Policy is made available to parents on request. The school has an Accessibility Plan for the physically disabled.

The majority of pupils transfer to the following secondary schools:-

- Ysgol Bryn Elan, Colwyn Bay.

LEA preference forms are distributed to parents during the first term prior to transition.

Disgyblaeth

Ein nod yw creu awyrgylch gynnes a chroesawgar o fewn yr ysgol er mwyn sicrhau fod pob disgybl a rhiant yn teimlo'n gartrefol yn ein mysg.

Mae gofal am y disgyblion yn gyfrifoldeb pob aelod o staff. Annogir y disgyblion i ddangos parch at eraill, at eiddo, ac i ddatblygu agwedd a pherthynas o ofal a goddefgarwch gyda'u cyfoedion, oedolion a phethau byw. Rhoddir cyfleoedd i'r disgyblion i ymestyn eu potensial ymhob agwedd o ddatblygiad, sef yn foesol, cymdeithasol, emosiynol, corfforol ac addysgiadol.

Rydym fel ysgol wedi mabwysiadu canllawiau Disgyblaeth Bendant pan yn delio ag ymddygiad disgyblion, sy'n golygu bod disgyblion sy'n cadw rheolau'r ysgol ac yn gweithio'n dda yn cael eu canmol yn rheolaidd, ac yn esiampl dda i eraill o ymddygiad ddisgwylidig. Cedwir rheolau dosbarth ac ysgol yn syml, ond pan fo disgybl yn gwrthod dilyn rheolau ac wedi derbyn sawl rhybudd, yna cysylltir â rhieni. Am fwy o fanylion, mae Polisi Disgyblaeth a Pholisi Bwlio ar gael i rieni yn yr ysgol. Byddwn yn cadw cofnod o ymddygiad annerbyniol cyson yn yr ysgol.

Discipline

Our aim is to create a warm and welcoming school atmosphere to ensure that pupils, and parents feel welcome.

All staff will make it their priority to ensure that children feel safe and secure at the school. Pupils are encouraged to show respect for people and property, and to develop tolerance and a caring attitude in their relationship with peers, adults and living things. Pupils are given opportunities to extend their individual potential in every aspect of development – moral, social, emotional, physical and intellectual.

As a school we have adopted an Assertive Discipline behaviour programme, which means that we have a positive approach to discipline, and always praise those pupils who follow school rules and work hard, and who set a good example for what is expected classroom behaviour. School and classroom rules are kept simple, but when a child continues to ignore rules, and have been given maximum warnings, then parents are contacted. Our Discipline and Bullying Policies are available at school. A record of regular unacceptable behaviour is kept at school.

Cludiant

Medication

As a general rule, medicines should not be sent to school, and teachers are not obliged to administer them, unless the circumstances are exceptional. If your child must have medicine during the school day, then parents are asked to fill in a consent form which is available at the school.

The school views sporting activities as a vital component of education. The facilities at the school include an equipped hall for gymnastics lessons, and full use of a sports field and a tennis court for outdoor games and activities. The school makes use of Colwyn Bay Leisure centre for swimming lessons. Pupils are encouraged to take part in all kinds of competitive sports in and out of school hours.

R.E is taught weekly and the school follows Conwy Education Authority's agreed Syllabus for Religious Education. Alternative arrangements are made for those pupils whose parents wish to withdraw for all or part of Religious Education lessons.



Gwasanaeth Cyd-addoli

Collective Worship

Daily worship reflects the ethos and values we have in common with the Church in Wales. Whole school Christian Collective Worship is held three times per week as well as two classroom assemblies. The PATHS course is followed on a weekly basis throughout the school. Alternative arrangements are made for those pupils whose parents wish to withdraw for all or part of Collective Worship.

Cyngor Ysgol a Chyngor Eco

School Council and Eco Council

They organise charity fundraising events, put forward suggestions for school effectiveness improvements and ensure that pupils have an opportunity to be responsible for aspects of school life. New members are elected annually.

The school governing body is committed to securing a high standard of the health, safety and well-being of staff, pupils, visitors and contractors in line with the school policy and also Conwy County health and safety policy. It is every member of staff's responsibility to be aware of any child protection issues that arise. All concerns regarding these issues must be reported to the Social Services. The Headteacher is responsible for looked after children. If the Headteacher is absent the second child protection co-ordinator takes the responsibility.
